




## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 by Age Group


## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 by Gender





## United States Adults Age 18-64 by Race/Ethnicity




## Washington State Adults Age 18-64 by Race/Ethnicity


## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Distribution of Racial/Ethnic Group by Age Group




## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent With and Without a Disability and With and Without LTSS Need


## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent With A Disability By Type of Disability


## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent of Residents With and Without Disabilities By Demographic Subgroup

## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Distribution of Residents, People with Disabilities, and People with LTSS Needs By Race/Ethnicity









## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent With Each Type of LTSS Need





## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent of Residents With and Without LTSS Need By Demographic Subgroup






## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 With LTSS Needs By Whether the Onset of Disability Occurred Before or After Age 18

## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 With LTSS Needs By Whether They Are Receiving Needed Assistance



■ Males ■ Females



## WA State Adults Age 18-64 Percent of Subgroups with Disability, LTSS Need, Not Receiving Sufficient Help That Is Rural



## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent of Residents in Group with a Disability, LTSS Need, and Receipt of Help By Demographic Subgroup





## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent With LTSS Needs By Income Group and By Whether Receiving Needed Help




### WA State Population Age 18-64 By Medicare and/or Medicaid Enrollment, CY2018


## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Age 18-64 by Program







## Washington State Residents Ages 18-64 Percent of Each Racial/Ethnic Category By Enrollment in Medicare and/or Medicaid











## Washington State Residents Age 18-64 Percent of Racial/Ethnic Group By Enrollment in Medicare and/or Medicaid





## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Ages 18-64 Prevalence of Disability Categories (Duplicated Counts)




## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Ages 18-64 with Disabilities by Disability and Co-Occurring Disability Category

## Washington State Medicaid and/or Medicare Beneficiaries Ages 18-64 by Disability Status and LTSS Receipt by State Agency







Age Distribution





## Washington State LTSS Recipients Age 18-64 by Age Group and State Agency, CY 2018



## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicare Beneficiaries Age 18-64 Percent Receiving LTSS, 2018 By Race/Ethnicity







## Washington State LTSS Recipients Ages 18-64 Prevalence of Disability Categories





## Washington State LTSS Recipients Ages 18-64 with a Single and Co-Occurring Disability Category Percentage with Each Disability Category



## Washington State LTSS Recipients Ages 18-64 by Disability and Co-Occurring Disability Category







## Washington State In-Home and Residential HCBS Recipients Age 18-64 Number of Recipients by ADL Score





## Washington State LTSS Recipients Age 18-64 by Setting of Care





## Washington State LTSS Recipients Age 18-64 Number of In-Home Clients by Base In-Home Hours of Personal Care per Month



## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Age 18-64 By Receipt of LTSS or Risk of Needing LTSS




## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Age 18-64 By Receipt of LTSS or Risk of Needing LTSS By Age Group

## Washington State Medicare and/or Medicaid Beneficiaries Age 18-64 By Receipt of LTSS or Risk of Needing LTSS By Gender


















