ACL Organizational Chart



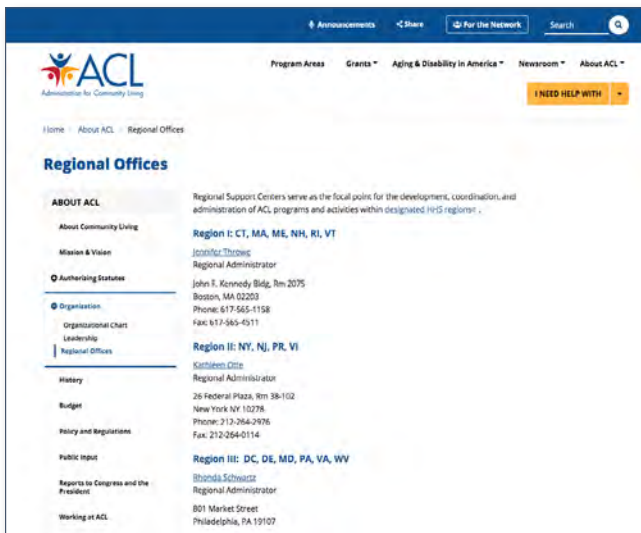

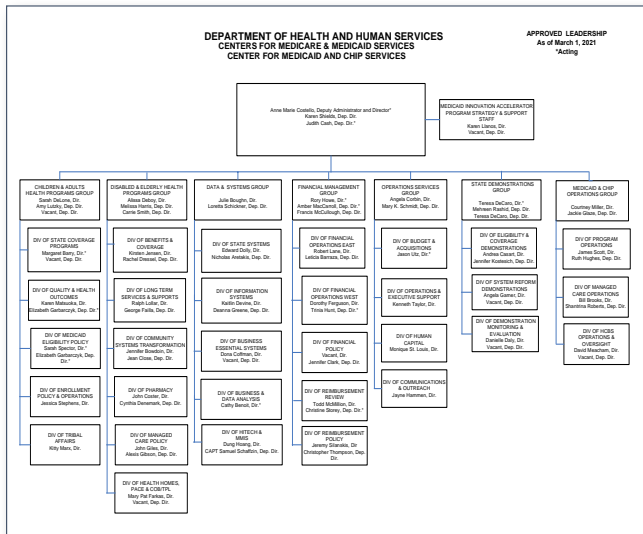

ADvancing States Map of all State Plans on Aging



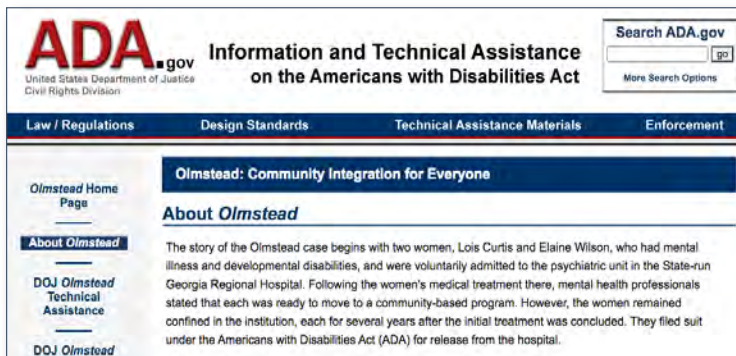
