ARPA HCBS Spending Plan Analysis



On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 into law. This legislation was an extensive and wide-ranging set of policies and funding to address the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting disruption to the American economy. One of the many items in the Act provides a 10% increase to the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) for Medicaid home and community-based services (HCBS). CBO estimated that states would receive – collectively – an additional \$12.7 billion in Federal funds. ²

Since passage of ARPA, CMS has released two State Medicaid Director Letters which provided guidance to states on the process to seek CMS approval of the activities on which the additional Federal funds can be spent³. States were required to submit a 'ARPA Spending Plan' to CMS for review and approval no later than July 11, 2021. States now must provide semi-annual updates on that spending plan — addressing changes and/or additions to that initial submission - as well as spending plan projections that estimate how much of the additional Federal funds have been spent.

States have a wide range of discretion for how to invest the funding, including direct services, eligibility expansions, provider payment increases, recruitment and retention activities, improving quality, and strengthening program administration and oversight.

ADvancing States conducted an analysis of the states' initial spending plans in September 2021 as a snapshot in time. We produced ten tables which categorized states' initiatives into topic areas including:

- Service Expansions
- Eligibility and Enrollment Activities
- Provider Payment Increases
- Direct Care Worker Recruitment, Retention, and Training
- Technology for Providers
- Technology for State Agencies
- Capital/Structural Improvements
- Quality Initiatives
- Strengthening State Administration
- Other Activities (not captured elsewhere)

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We have now updated that analysis with information from most states' most recent spending plan updates to CMS (submitted in either October, 2022 or January 2023).⁴ Again, this is a snapshot in time analysis and may not reflect a state's current activities.

Over time, states have refined their approaches and/or have received feedback from CMS that some proposed initiatives did not meet the statutory direction to 'enhance, expand or strengthen HCBS'.

Readers will note the following in the tables:

- If a state removed a specific initiative, the X in the table representing that initiative has been struck through and highlighted in red. Likewise, an explanation of the removal (if available) can be found in the notes column also highlighted in red.
- If a state added a new initiative, there is a X in the appropriate column highlighted in green. Similarly, if there was information available about the new initiative, the description can be found in the notes column also highlighted in green.

Our analysis is based on spending plan updates submitted to CMS; there may be additional nuances that were not captured. For a fuller picture of a state's entire spending plan, we suggest relying states' publicly available spending plans and updates found on state government websites and/or the CMS ARPA 9817 webpage.

Finally, though the public tables are high-level, ADvancing States has compiled more detailed information that is available to state agencies upon request.
